Y6 SATs week

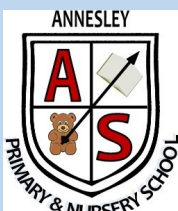
The year 6 end of primary school tests (SATs) will take place week commencing Monday 11th May. If your child is in year 6, please note that tests will be administered on Monday 11th May, Tuesday 12th May, Wednesday 13th May and Thursday 14th May. PE Kit

Parents 4 Pupils (P4P)

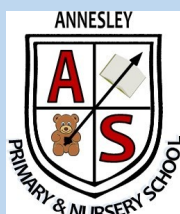
A big thank you to the P4P Team for treating all our children to an Easter Egg which were delivered by the Easter Bunny yesterday.
