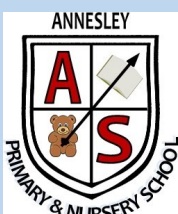
Pumpkin Discos

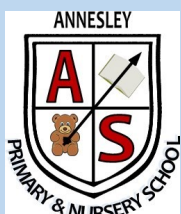
Golden Book Assembly
