Miss Geeson will be leaving us and taking up a teaching assistant position in another school.

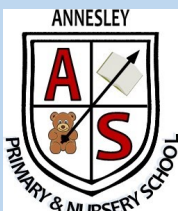
Miss Snape has taken up a teaching position at another school and will also be leaving us.

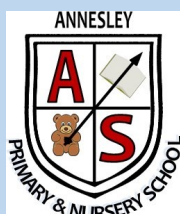
Tickets for the discos are now for sale on Parent Pay from Monday 10th July. They are £4 and include a hot dog or pizza.

Nottingham City Council Catering, our suppliers of school dinners, are increasing their prices in the new school year. From September, a school dinner will be £2.50 for the main school and £2.15 for nursery.

Nursery lunchtime and afternoon session price change

The price of lunchtime and afternoon nursery sessions will be increasing in the new school year. This will be the first price rise in over 8 years. From September, a lunchtime session will cost £3.50 and an afternoon session will be £15.

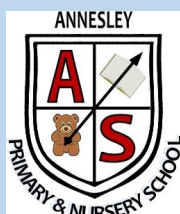
Year 4 have arrived at The Mill Adventure Base for their residential stay. They are having a great time!
