I have also included on this front page the school holiday pattern for next academic year (2023-24) and a list of our Inset dates.

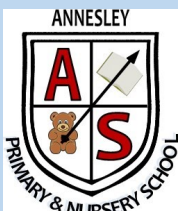

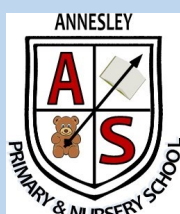

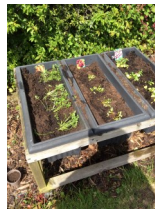
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EYFS

F2 children have been planting their own vegetables to go alongside their farm topic. They planted carrots, beetroot and radishes.

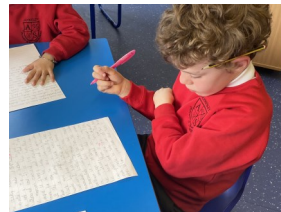
Year 1
